

**Endangered Wolf Center** 

• June 15, 2018 Come along with us as we explore the *Wild Side* of the St. Louis area! Whether an animal lover or not, you won't want to miss this trip as we go to all extremes to see as many critters as possible on our journey in one day!

We'll start our critter crawl in Eureka, MO at the **Endangered Wolf Center**. This internationally recognized captive breeding

facility raises endangered wolves and releases them back into the wild. Family packs of highly endangered North American Red, Maned & Mexican Wolves, Swift & Fennec Foxes and African Painted Dogs are all housed in their natural habitats here onsite.



Then we're off to <u>Grant's</u> Farm, home to more than 900 critters representing

more than 100 species from six continents. On our Critter Crawl here we'll find the world famous Clydesdale horses, a deer park, elephants, tropical birds, kangaroos, tortoises and so much more. While here you'll receive a voucher and have different choices to choose from for your lunch.

Ready to hear about a unique rescue ministry? Well that's where we're headed next, to Ballwin, to the <u>Wildlife Rescue Center</u>, where they rehabilitate injured, sick and orphaned native wildlife and release healthy animals back to their natural habitat. Since 1979, WRC has treated more than 30,000 native wild patients and today, over 2,000 patients are treated in their 9,000 square ft facility and expansive outdoor enclosures. You won't believe your eyes!

Then we'll have a wonderful dinner @ Cracker Barrel before heading home with a sense that we've truly been with the greatest of all critters created by God.
