



This afternoon we'll head to the Fort Scott National Historic Site for a guided tour to learn the history of this place, where promises were made and broken, the town was attacked at dawn, thousands were made homeless by war and soldiers were fighting settlers.

You'll then have time to shop at your own leisure in the downtown stores where you'll receive Downtown Discount Cards from the Chamber.

Before we leave Fort Scott we'll stop off at the Anderson Elk Ranch for a tour and to learn all about raising elk, tasting the meat and seeing these marvels up close and personal!
