Apollo 11 was the spaceflight that landed the first two humans on the Moon. Mission commander Neil Armstrong and pilot Buzz Aldrin, both American, landed the lunar module Eagle on July 20, 1969, at 20:18 UTC. Armstrong became the first to step onto the lunar surface six hours after landing on July 21 at 02:56:15.

Visitors can practice landing the lunar module and space shuttle, or docking the Gemini capsule, as Neil Armstrong did in 1966. We'll check in to our hotel and then head to Moon City Music where we'll enjoy an OVER THE MOON experience all in one location.... a great buffet meal, history and entertainment such as Bad Moon Arising, Fly Me To The Moon, Blue Moon, Moon River and more.

On our fourth day, we'll get up and head to Jackson Center, OH and tour the Airstream Factory that gives visitors an opportunity to see how the American Legend Airstream is built. Also, the Apollo 11 Astronauts spent several days in NASA's Mobile Quarantine Facility when they returned from the moon, which was actually a converted airstream travel trailer. Then we're off to Center Point, IN to the Exotic Feline Rescue Center for a tour. We'll then check into Drury Inn at Terra Haute, IN for the evening.

On day five, we head out for a visit to Clabber Girl which includes a cooking demonstration and appetizers. Then we'll head to Casey, IL to see several Guinness World Record constructions. You won't even believe it. We'll visit the Candy Depot, have lunch at Richards Farm Restaurant and then head home.
